

Calgary Resident Plans Home Renovations After Winning "Robson Arms Rent Control" Contest on RobsonArms.CTV.ca

After navigating through a virtual Robson Arms and finding Bobbi (Gabrielle Miller) her rent money, Calgary's Daniel Kerr has won \$12,000 towards his mortgage payments for one year thanks to an online "Robson Arms Rent Control" game at **robsonarms.CTV.ca**. The contest served as a companion to Season 3 of **Robson Arms**. Encore episodes of the third season air **Tuesdays at 8:30 p.m. ET**, following *Canadian Idol* on CTV (visit CTV.ca to confirm local broadcast times).

"I was really excited to hear that I had won," said Kerr. "With my mortgage payments taken care of for the next year, I can now spend my money on home improvements!"

Kerr, a roofing contractor from Calgary, Alberta, signed on to the Web site after seeing the game promo during *Robson Arms* this spring.

Launched at the beginning of Season 3, "Robson Arms Rent Control" was a virtual game that had players embark on a quest to help Bobbi (Gabrielle Miller) find her rent money so that she didn't get evicted from Robson Arms. Players had to hunt through the apartments of Robson Arms tenants Nick (Fred Ewanuick), Hal (Zak Santiago), Yuri (John Cassini), Chuck (Dave Foley) and Trixie (Allison Hossack) to locate Bobbi's missing money, and to collect designated items. Once participants travelled through all of the rooms, successfully completed the tasks and collected all of the key items, they were eligible to enter the contest for the chance to win free rent or mortgage payments – up to \$12,000 – for a year.
